And in that moment, he sets himself upon a different course, albeit a tiresome track at times."

Throughout the book, readers will be awakened to the following themes:

- There is a gift awaiting us all, if we are willing to look within
- It does not matter so much what we call the higher power, only that we call it often
- Every person has a greater version of themselves waiting to come out
- Love is the secret to the kingdom we are heir to
- Throughout history, masters have stood out who have been able to convey an extraordinary message through their craft

"When I wrote the book," adds David, "it was my hope that it would resonate with anyone who is in search of something more. I simply tapped into the wiser side of me, in me, and let it lead the process. My mind had other ideas. Many other ideas. But it was only when I let my heart lead – my spiritual heart – that the book unfolded in the manner that is now bound and out in the world."

David Scott was born in the United States, and raised in the world. He currently resides in Singapore, but remains deeply connected to the passion that is Paris, the power shift that finds its new home in Asia, and the movement to co-create and cooperate that had its genesis for him in America; its inspiration both within and throughout.
